HIGHWAY ACT 1890

Sections 137 & 148

Please keep all public roads clear of mud, manure and debris. Vehicle operators who deposit mud on the road are potentially liable for a range of offences as per the Highways Act. You are responsible for preventing mud, manure & debris being deposited on the road. This includes cleaning the above mentioned from vehicles, as far as practicable, before they enter onto the road.
