Federal and Provincial Governments Invest in the Community of Paisley in the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie

August 9, 2021

The federal and provincial governments have announced that the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie has received funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program. This funding is to execute two projects in Paisley that focus on accessibility and modernization of recreational spaces. A total of \$242,251 in federal and provincial funding has been received for an accessible lift at the Paisley Town Hall as well as the Paisley Community Centre Community Hub project for necessary improvements to the second floor of the Paisley Community Centre. In order to provide more space and enhanced programming, Arran-Elderslie is working with Bruce County to relocate the Paisley library to the second floor.

Through the Investing in Canada infrastructure plan, the Government of Canada is investing more than \$180 billion over 12 years in public transit projects, green infrastructure, social infrastructure, trade and transportation routes, and Canada's rural and northern communities. Ontario is investing over \$10.2 billion under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program to improve public transit; community, culture and recreation; green, and rural and northern community and other priority infrastructure. Arran-Elderslie greatly appreciates being a recipient of a portion of these available funds.

These projects will provide our residents and visitors access to modern local infrastructure where they can maintain an active and healthy lifestyle.
