## Arran-Elderslie Reminds Residents to Stay Vigilant Against COVID-19

As the holiday season quickly approaches, Arran-Elderslie Council would like to remind you and your family to stay vigilant on the fight against COVID-19. Please continue to utilize precautionary methods such as masks, hand washing, physical distancing and capacity limits to reduce the spread of COVID-19. If you have symptoms, please stay home.

There has been a recent increase in COVID-19 cases and associated outbreaks in Grey Bruce. Please refer to the Grey Bruce Health Unit webpage for up to date information.

If you are not vaccinated, there are a number of upcoming vaccine clinics in Grey Bruce.

For the week of December 13 – December 19, the Grey Bruce Health Unit will hold vaccine clinics at the following locations and times. **Those receiving a third dose and those 5-11 years of age need an appointment.** First and second doses for all individuals 12 and over do not require an appointment (walk-in). On Monday December 18<sup>th</sup>, those over 18 years of age are eligible for a third dose. Appointments for a third dose must be at least 3 months after your second dose.
