Dear business owner/operator,

The Municipality of Arran-Elderslie will join Ontario's new recycling program on January 1, 2026. In this provincial initiative, producers—those supplying blue box materials—will assume both financial and operational responsibility for recycling.

One advantage of the change is that more types of materials can be recycled, but it also means some adjustments for local businesses and organizations that previously used curbside pickup.

According to the legislation, businesses, commercial farms, places of worship, non-profits, and other institutions are considered **ineligible sources**, and are not eligible for Ontario's curbside Blue Box program. As a result of these changes, curbside collection will end for these groups beginning January 1, 2026. Blue cardboard dumpsters (convenience depots) will also be removed as of January 1, 2026, because of this legislative change.

Ineligible properties will need to arrange their own contractor to collect recyclable items and cardboard from their premises. For your convenience, a list of potential contractors is provided; however, you are welcome to select a contractor of your own.


